Antique Tractor Pull Points Guidelines

1. Members of the Western Michigan Old Engine Club who participate in the Antique Tractor Pulls will be eligible to earn points to determine an annual points champion in each pulling class.
2. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - 3 points for first place
 - 2 points for second place
 - 1 points for third place
3. In addition to points being awarded for placing, each registered driver will receive one participation point. The tractor must at least enter the pulling track under its own power in order to receive the participation point. If a driver registers but withdraws the entry prior to entering the pulling track, that driver will forfeit the participation point.
4. Any disqualification will result in forfeiture of any scoring points earned. If a driver is disqualified after having made a pulling attempt, his or she will not forfeit the participation point.
5. The points earned are earned for the tractor and driver together. A driver can only earn points on one tractor per class. If a driver enters a second tractor in the same class during the pulling season, that second tractor will earn separate points. Points earned by one driver operating different tractors in the same class will not be accumulated.
6. Tie breakers for the determination of points champions will be handled as follows:

The first tie breaker will be the total number of participation points. The driver with the most participation points will be declared the winner. If a tie is still in place after the participation points are tallied then the 2nd tie breaker will be the total number of full pulls, followed by the total number of first place finishes, the total number of second place finishes and the total number of third place finishes. The final tie breaker will be the total number of full pulls earned during the pulling season. If after all levels have been evaluated and a tie still exists, then a tie will be declared.
7. Seasonal awards will be given for the top three positions in each class.
